Gulliver was carried in a large wooden frame moving upon twenty- two wheels. Finally, they arrived at the Emperor's palace. The Emperor came to receive Gulliver and told him that he could stay in Lilliput only on the condition if he swears to protect his kingdom. Gulliver agreed and was immediately freed. He was provided with food and water, and house was built for him.

One day, Lilliput's enemy kingdom Blefuscu attacked it. The king of Blefuscu brought an army of a hundred ships to attack Lilliput. Gulliver went to help the kingdom. He took a long rope and tied all the enemy ships and dragged them out of the sea. The king of Blefuscu ended the war and settled for peace. Hence, Gulliver won the trust of the Emperor of Lilliput.
