Overall, the Best Out of Waste Activity was an enriching and enjoyable experience that reinforced the message of reducing waste and contributing towards a greener and more sustainable future.

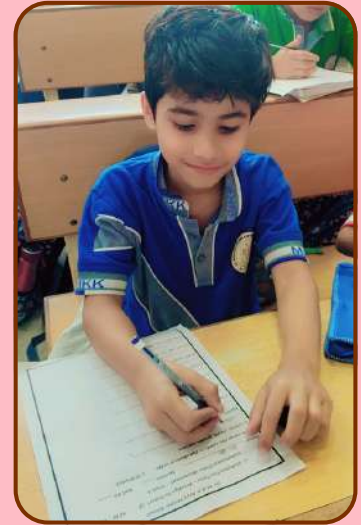
ABC Word Express (Alphabetical Order)

Teachers guided and motivated the students to speak clearly and confidently. The activity created a joyful learning environment and helped the children overcome stage fear.



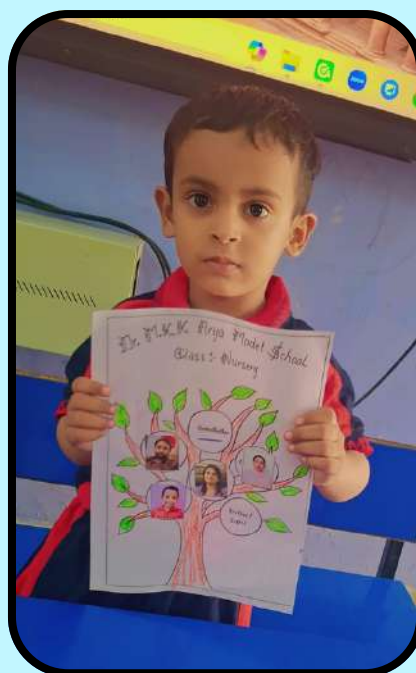

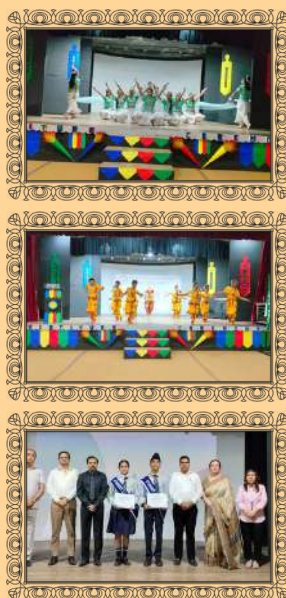
Investiture Ceremony 2026-27

The event concluded with smiles, happiness and cherished memories. The celebration successfully strengthened the bond between mothers and children and made the day truly memorable for everyone.

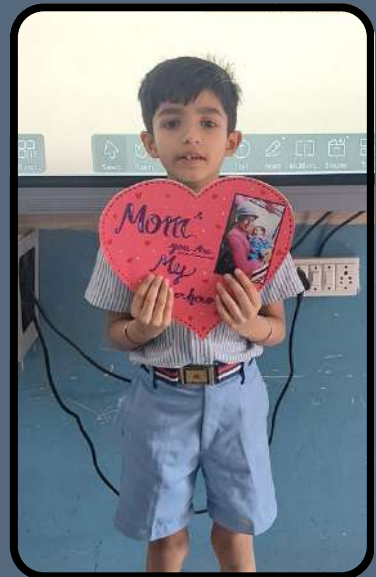
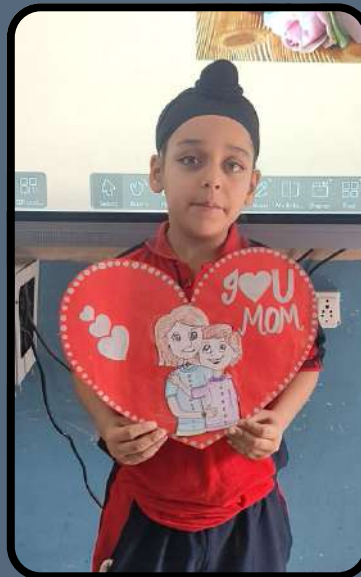
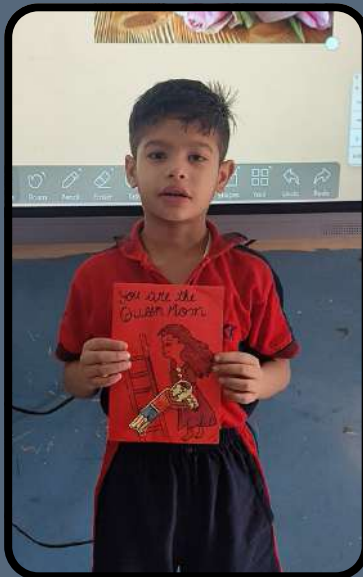
My Mother, My Superhero

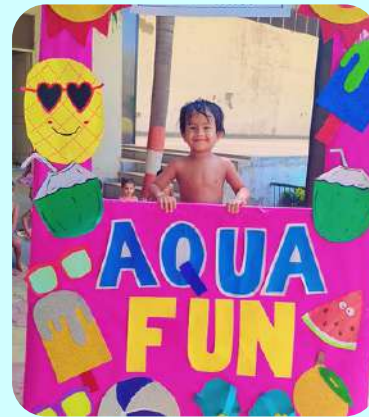
Aqua Fun Day

English Creative Writing Activity☆☆

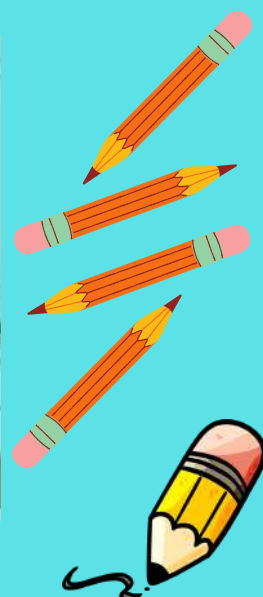
May 23, 2026

Robotics Education Programme



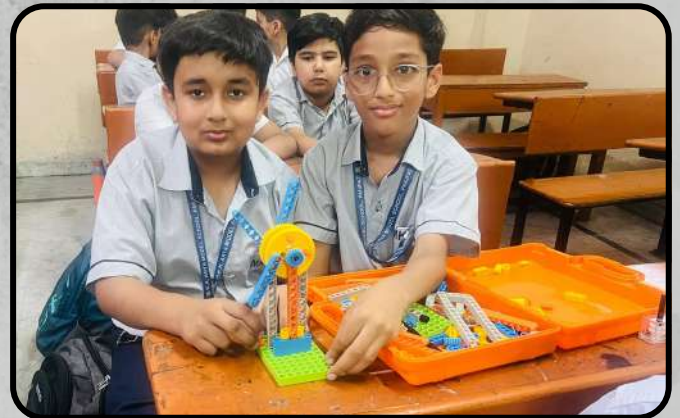

HPV Vaccination Drive



May 13-22, 2026

Dr. M.K.K. Arya Model School, Panipat, successfully organised an HPV Vaccination Drive from May 13 to May 22, 2026, for girl students in the age group of 14–15 years. The initiative aimed to create awareness about preventive healthcare and protect students against Human Papillomavirus (HPV), which can cause cervical cancer later in life. A total of 102 girl students were identified under the eligible age group. Parents were contacted, and vaccination was administered after obtaining their consent. As a result, 24 girl students received the HPV vaccine at the school, while 6 students were vaccinated at other healthcare facilities.

The vaccination drive was conducted by a team of doctors, nurses, and ASHA workers from the Primary Health Centre, Batra Colony, and Civil Hospital, Panipat. The entire process was carried out smoothly and safely and no adverse reactions were reported among the vaccinated students. Vaccination certificates were sent to the parents on their registered mobile numbers. The programme was organized under the guidance of Principal, Dr. Manoj Sarin and coordinated by Dr. Anjali Dewan, Nodal Officer, whose dedicated efforts ensured the smooth execution of this important health initiative.
